



Visit insurance.pa.gov and check out the Consumer's Checkbook plan comparison tool.

You can also use a broker or health insurance company website to shop, but be careful:

- Make sure the plan you select is considered minimum essential coverage so you don't have to pay a penalty
- Make sure the plan covers your medical needs
- New plans should cover certain preventive services, like shots and screening tests, at no cost to you.
- You should not be charged a fee to enroll

Open enrollment starts on November 1 and ends December 15.

If you want your coverage to start on January 1, you must sign up by December 15.
